4. Elements of Successful RFEOI's
 - a. Supported by a Wildfire Mitigation Strategy
 - b. Proposed work is on a high-hazard fuels or on other high priority activities recommended in mitigation strategy (e.g. targeted education activities, cross-training, etc.)
 - c. Proposed work is in high risk communities
 - d. Proponent can demonstrate significant buy in and support (financial or otherwise) for the proposed work (not just passive sign off on a proposal because there is a funding opportunity).
